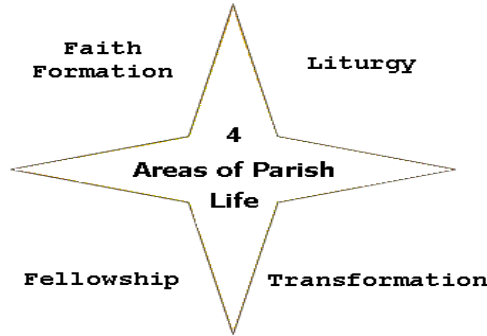

WEEKLY FOOD DONATION OFFERINGS



Do you know?

At every weekend mass at Our Lady of Victory and St. Malachy, offerings are brought up to the altar. First, there is the bread and wine, the weekly collections, and then the non-perishable food collected in the baskets at the entrance of the churches. Do you know what we do with the food collected? And what about those cereal bars collected at OLV once a month?

The non-perishable food is sorted, for delivery to the local food bank (La mie de l'entraide) and the local soup kitchen (La Table de Bethlehem) which provides hot lunches to school-aged children in the basement of the St. Grégoire church every school-day lunch hour. The cereal bars are delivered to the Buckingham Elementary School to nourish those in need.

Jesus often spoke in his sermons about the need to assist and help the less fortunate and those in need. Through this program of food donations, our two parishes are doing their best to "walk the talk". The Transformation Committee thanks everyone for these weekly donations.

These bags are cut into strips and put together to make sleeping mats for the people of Haiti, they are used as packing material to ship products and therefore there is no cost to ship the mats to Haiti. Insects and poisonous spiders do not like the plastic and will not hide in the mat. It takes 300 to 500 bags to make one mat.
