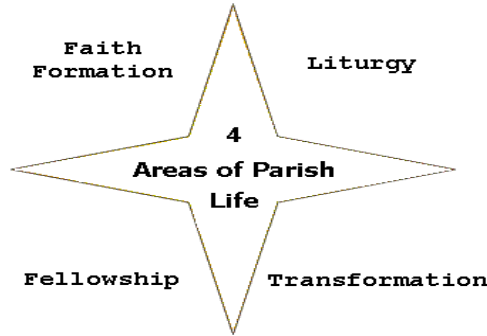

#### **SAINT JOSEPH'S ORATORY NEWS**

Daily masses are scheduled for visitors, one in French at 11:30 AM, and in English at 12:15 PM with a free organ concert held every Sunday at 3:30 PM, as well as daily carillon recitals. Guided tours are also offered on a daily basis at 10:00 AM, 1:30 PM and 3:00 PM. When visiting the Oratory, visitors are encouraged to visit the **Gardens of the Oratory** with the way of the cross, as well as the new exhibit in the Oratory on Brother André, the Saint of Mont Royal. At the Oratory, the month of August will be dedicated to Brother André. As part of this celebration, several special activities are planned:

- On Saturday, August 6<sup>th</sup>, there will be a day of Reconciliation at the Oratory.
