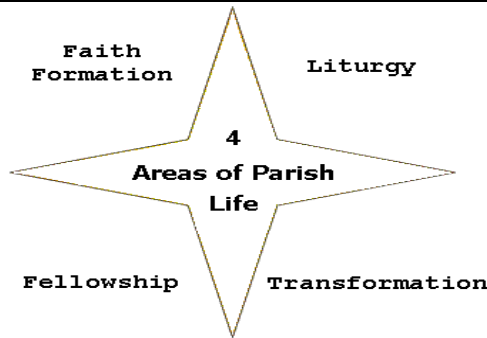

**NEW TRANSLATION OF THE ROMAN MISSAL**

On the First Sunday of Advent 2011, we will begin to use the new English translation of the Roman Missal. Over the last few weeks, we detailed some of the new responses called for in the New Roman Missal. This week, the new Memorial Acclamation and Communion declaration are given below. The changes are in bold face and underlined.

*Priest:* The mystery of faith.

*All:* **We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again.**

Or:

When we eat this bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your Death, **O Lord,** until you come **again.**

Or:

**Save us, Saviour of the world, for** by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free.

*Priest:* Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world.  
Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.

*All:* Lord, I am not worthy **that you should enter under my roof**, but only say the word and **my soul** shall be healed.
