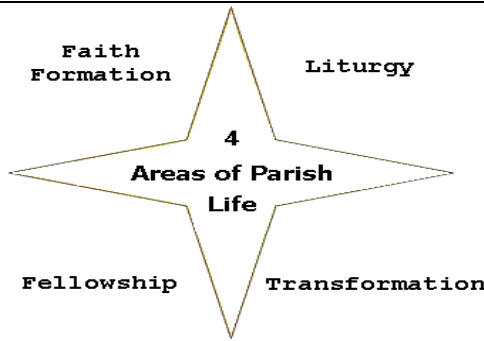

ARCHBISHOP ÉBACHER'S ANNIVERSARY

On October 6th, Archbishop Ébacher celebrated his 75th birthday. According to the Code of Canon Law, upon reaching 75 years of age, bishops send their resignations to the Pope. However, they remain bishops until such time as the resignation is accepted and a new bishop is appointed.

CONFERENCE WITH MGR. CHACOUR, MELKITE CATHOLIC ARCHBISHOP IN ISRAEL

Development and Peace, the Gatineau Diocese and CNEWA Canada (Catholic Near East Welfare Association) are hosting a conference with Mgr. Elias Chacour on *Le futur de la chrétienté en Terre sainte et au Moyen-Orient (The Future of Christianity on the Holy Land and the Middle-East)*. Mgr. Chacour, a Christian Palestinian, is a Melkite Catholic Archbishop of Haïfa, Nazareth and Galilee. He is well-known internationally for his peace initiatives in Israel, in Palestine as well as among Jews, Christians and Muslims. He will be speaking about the challenges facing Christians and their role in building sustainable peace in this troubled region. Although the conference will take place in French, Mgr. Chacour speaks English and would be able to respond to English questions. Everyone is welcome.
