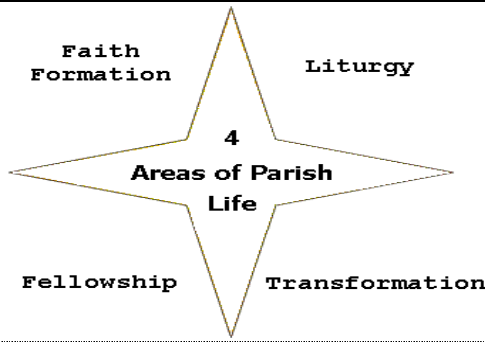

WE HAVE A NEW ARCHBISHOP!

On Tuesday, October 11th 2011, His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI accepted the resignation of the Most Reverend Roger Ébacher and named the Most Reverend Paul-André Durocher as Archbishop of Gatineau. At the time of his appointment, Archbishop Durocher was Bishop of Alexandria-Cornwall. Archbishop Ébacher had been responsible for the Archdiocese of Gatineau for 23 years. He had offered his resignation after becoming 75 years old, as stipulated by the Code of Canon Law.

Bishop Durocher was born on May 28, 1954, in Windsor, Ontario. He was ordained to the priesthood on July 2, 1982, for the Diocese of Timmins and appointed Auxiliary Bishop of Sault Ste. Marie on January 20, 1997. On April 26, 2002, he was appointed Bishop of Alexandria-Cornwall.

Archbishop-elect Durocher serves on the Executive Committee of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) as its current Co-Treasurer. He is also a member of its French Sector Episcopal Commission for Liturgy and the Sacraments.

Our faith community looks forward to meeting with our new Archbishop.

Mgr. Ébacher will celebrate a Thanksgiving Mass to which all are invited. The mass will be celebrated at the St. Joseph Cathedral on Tuesday, November 1st at 6:30 pm. A reception will follow in the cathedral basement. This will give everyone an opportunity to extend best wishes and thanks to Mgr. Ébacher. It will also be possible to leave cards and gifts in special boxes. A bursary for Mgr. Ébacher will be created with the donations.

CONFERENCE WITH MGR. CHACOUR, MELKITE CATHOLIC ARCHBISHOP IN ISRAEL

Development and Peace, the Gatineau Diocese and CNEWA Canada (Catholic Near East Welfare Association) are hosting a conference with Mgr. Elias Chacour on *Le futur de la chrétienté en Terre sainte et au Moyen-Orient (The Future of Christianity on the Holy Land and the Middle-East)*. Mgr. Chacour, a Christian Palestinian, is a Melkite Catholic Archbishop of Haifa, Nazareth and Galilee. He is well-known internationally for his peace initiatives in Israel, in Palestine as well as among Jews, Christians and Muslims. He will be speaking about the challenges facing Christians and their role in building sustainable peace in this troubled region. Although the conference will take place in French, Mgr. Chacour speaks English and would be able to respond to English questions. Everyone is welcome.
