

TRANSITION AT THE DIOCESE

As announced last week, the Holy Father accepted Mgr Ébacher's resignation and named Mgr Paul-André Durocher as Archbishop of Gatineau. Our new Archbishop will be installed, or will officially take his office, on **November 30th** during a special mass that will be celebrated by the Apostolic Nuncio, His Excellency the Archbishop Pedro López Quintana. More information will follow. On October 25th, Mgr Durocher will meet the Diocese priests and pastoral agents.

We remind you that Mgr Ébacher will celebrate a Thanksgiving Mass, followed by a reception, to which we are all invited, on Tuesday, **November 1st at 6:30 p.m.** in **St. Joseph Cathedral.** Boxes will be available to leave cards and gifts. A bursary for Mgr Ébacher will be created with the donations.

WORLD MISSION SUNDAY - October 23rd 2011

Each year, on the occasion of World Mission Sunday, the Pontifical Society for the Propagation of the Faith invites all Christian communities to sustain the Churches most in need in Africa, Asia, Oceania, Europe and America, through prayer and donation. The monetary gifts constitute the Universal Solidarity Fund which is a sign of unity in faith, of communion in love and of justice.

This one and only collection on World Mission Sunday shows the communion and solidarity of our Church with the poorest Churches. This collection belongs to the 1,250 poorest dioceses who depend on the Pontifical Missionary Society of the Propagation of the Faith for their life and work.
