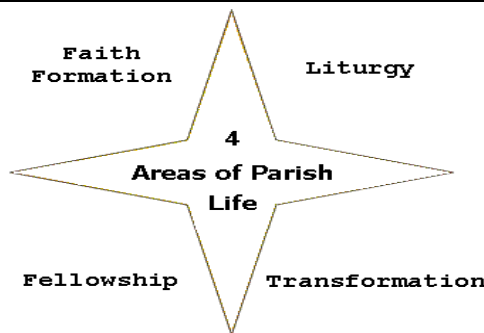

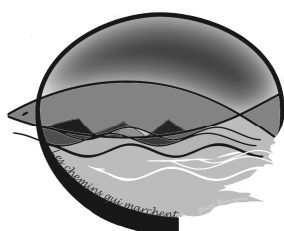
The temptation of Jesus. The devil tries us in a similar way.

The organization also supported 55 emergency relief programs—in 15 countries, including Haiti, Pakistan and the Sudan—worth \$16 million, for a total of \$28 million.

The Symbols of Solidarity that were brought forward in our churches this weekend (and will remain under the cross throughout Lent) help us to reflect on the direct connection between members of Development and Peace and our sisters and brothers in the Global South. They are a visible reminder of how the work of our partners is helping a world of justice take root in the Philippines, Cambodia and Lebanon.
