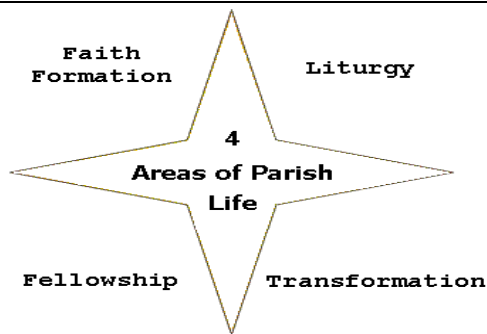

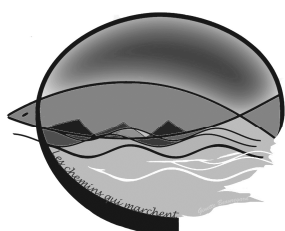
**2<sup>ND</sup> SUNDAY OF LENT – MARCH 3-4, 2012**
