

## 5<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY OF LENT – MARCH 25<sup>th</sup>, 2012 A Cry for Justice

The Church, in faithfulness to the teaching of Holy Scripture, urges us to unite ourselves to this clamour of the world and to turn it into a prayer that reaches our Father God. At the same time she impels and urges us to live the demands that justice makes on our personal lives at a professional and social level, and to defend those who – because they are weaker – cannot avail themselves of their rights. The Christian is not expected to make sterile lamentations. Instead of complaining, Our Lord wants us to atone for the acts of injustice which are daily committed throughout the world: He wants us to try to remedy as many injustices as we can, starting with those that occur closest to us, in the sphere in which we move, just there where we live.

Today is solidarity Sunday, as announced in last weeks Bulletin. There are D & P envelopes at the entrance of the church for those who do not have collection envelopes.

In July 2010, Development and Peace submitted a funding proposal of \$49.2 million to CIDA for the programs over the next five years. They have finally received the government's response. CIDA will contribute \$14.5 million, or \$2.9 million per year. Last year, it contributed \$8.2 million to programs that Development and Peace supports in the Global South and the North. If Development and Peace is to maintain its support to the Global South at the same level it is providing this year (186 projects in 30 countries), Development and Peace needs to raise \$5 million within the Church. Please try to increase your donation to the D&P special collection. We will be collecting for the next few weeks. We also wish to thank you for your continued generosity.
