



Now it is up to us to find in them the inspiration, boldness and passion required to proclaim the Christ's Gospel to a world in dire need of good news and of reasons for hope. Today we might keep two questions in our minds and hearts:

1. Have we fulfilled with conviction and joy the mission received from Jesus?
2. Do we wait in joyful hope for his second coming?

Joyful hope, not fear, is the proper attitude for Christians until the time set by God . and by God alone . for the return of Christ in glory.
