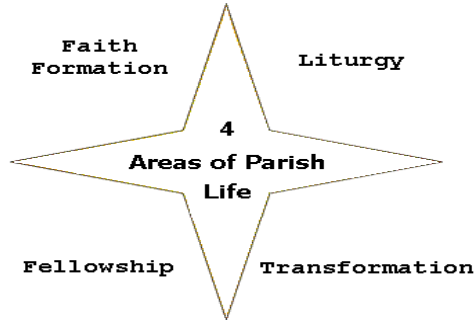

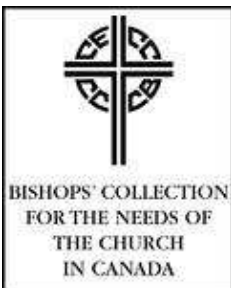

Joint campaign for ***Development and Peace*** and the **Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops**

Collection for the Needs of the Church in Canada

Since its foundation in 1943, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) has played an important role in helping the Church be present and involved, nationally and internationally. The CCCB is the country's national assembly of Catholic Bishops, including the Bishops of the Eastern Catholic Churches. It supports the Bishops in their pastoral ministry, in the fields of catechesis, ecumenism, interfaith relations, social justice, liturgy, doctrine, relations with Indigenous peoples, international aid and family life.

The *Collection for the Needs of the Church in Canada* will be held on September 29 and 30, 2012. Through your contribution to the Collection, you too can collaborate with the Bishops in their ministry to teach, sanctify and govern.

The CCCB offices are located at 2500 Don Reid Drive, in Ottawa, where a staff of approximately 30 provides various services to help support the pastoral work of the Bishops of Canada.

In total, 51 children attended the school, a number of which were from our two parishes.

This year, OLV has joined the Anglican Parishes of St. Stephen's in Buckingham, St. John's in Glen Almond, St. Thomas in Silver Creek, St. George's in Gatineau, and St. Andrew's United Church in Buckingham as an active partner in support of the vacation Bible school.

As a result of the camp's success, two associated ministries are being planned: a bi-monthly ecumenical Sunday school; and a Friday night youth program.

More information is to follow on the two new ministries, as well as the possibility of other joint projects will be forthcoming.
