Foundation

The Daisy Movement was founded on August 1, 1981 by Mrs. Louise Brazeau Ward, Aylmer, Quebec, Canada, in the Diocese of Gatineau Hull.

The purpose is to pray for priests, to offer one day a week for a particular priest and so to support him in his priestly ministry and spiritual life. What is expected from priests in their ministry is increasingly demanding; and the challenges of the new evangelization are numerous and complex. It is, therefore, good for priests to know that there are people committed to pray for them as a support to their ministry.

What is a Daisy?

A "Daisy" is a team of prayer partners, a group of seven persons praying for an 8th, their adopted priest. Around the "heart" (the priest), is a corolla of seven "petals" or prayer partners who have "adopted" a particular priest.

Symbolism:

Mrs. Louise Ward, the foundress, chose the daisy to symbolise the prayer commitment. For this seven-petaled flower symbolises quite well the characteristics of a praying heart: the gift of self, simplicity and unity.

How Do We Pray?

Each "petal" prays in his or her own way, as is most convenient for each one. The Daisy Movement does not propose any special formulas. "[A petal] has committed himself (herself) to offer each week a day of prayer at the intentions of the priest whom we have adopted, together with the six other petals who form our Daisy.

Growth, Expansion

After some 20 years, the Daisy Movement has spread across the world.
