**ARCHDIOCESE OF GATINEAU – 50<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY**

Last Thursday, Archbishop Paul-André Durocher officially launched the pastoral year, the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Diocese, with the theme "A Covenant Space". In attendance were diocesan priests, deacons, pastoral agents and people responsible for pastoral work either in their parishes or religious communities.

Many documents were distributed: the Archbishop's Pastoral Letter of May 27<sup>th</sup> announcing the Diocesan Jubilee Year, a pamphlet on proposed activities during the Year, a 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Prayer printed on a bookmark, a souvenir calendar for \$5, a pamphlet on the 2013 walking pilgrimage along the Gatineau River and finally, a hymn composed by Archbishop Durocher entitled "God of the Covenant". The launch was followed by a mass at St. Joseph's Cathedral to honour Mary, the Patroness of our Diocese.

During the Jubilee Year, the Archbishop hopes to visit all the parishes – March 9 and 10 have been reserved for the four parishes served by Fr. Gyan: St. Aloysius, Our Lady of Victory, St. Malachy and St. Columban. It was suggested that the parishes meet to prepare a joint program for his visit. Also planned during the year is a conference presented by Jean-Pierre Prévost on the theme "A Covenant Space" to all sectors of the diocese, including an English conference on November 6<sup>th</sup> at Our Lady of the Annunciation – more information to follow.

Many more activities are in the planning stages at various parishes and Archbishop Durocher asked all parishes to plan a special activity to celebrate our 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary
