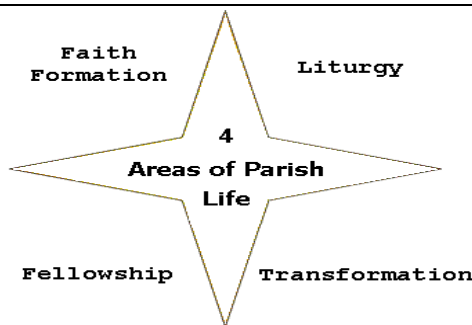

[The Episcopal Commission for Social Action \(CEAS\)](#), is providing training to local community leaders to help them understand their rights in the face of mining companies and other extractive industries in their communities, and is supporting them in defending those rights.
