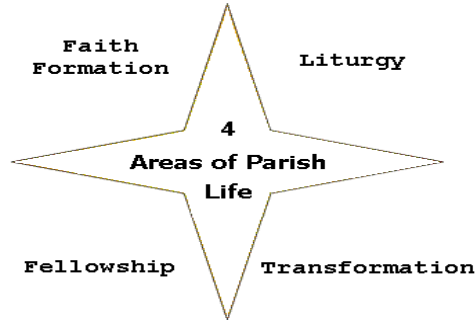

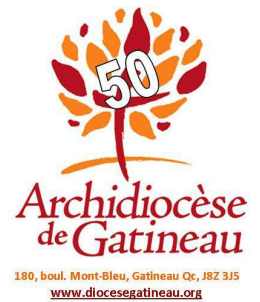

This coming Sunday also marks the start of a new year for the **Buckingham Ecumenical Sunday School**. The Sunday School will be meeting on **Sunday, September 8th at 11:30am at St. Stephen's Buckingham** and will continue to meet once a month at one of our partner churches for the rest of the school year.
