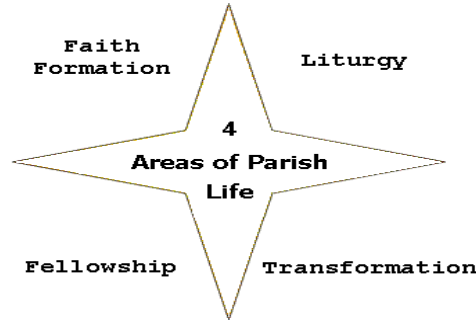

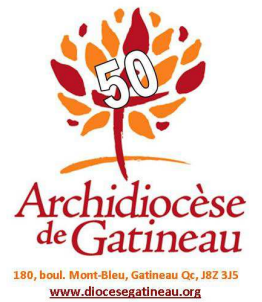

INTERVIEW WITH POPE FRANCIS:

Pope Francis has granted a lengthy interview, published in the Italian Jesuit magazine "La Civiltà Cattolica" and simultaneously in another sixteen magazines linked to the Society of Jesus throughout the world. The interview was the result of three private meetings and more than six hours of discussion between the Pope

and the editor of "La Civiltà Cattolica", Fr. Antonio Spadaro, during the month of August at the Santa Marta guesthouse.

In the interview, more than thirty pages long, the Pope talks frankly about himself, his artistic and literary tastes, and his experience in the Society of Jesus and as archbishop of Buenos Aires. He defines himself as "a sinner. This is the most accurate definition. It is not a figure of speech, a literary genre. I am a sinner."

CANADIAN CONFERENCE OF CATHOLIC BISHOPS (CCCB):

There is a new President of the CCCB – the Most Reverend Paul-André Durocher and Bishop of the Archdiocese of Gatineau.

The Catholic Bishops of Canada were in Plenary Assembly all last week at the Hotel Mont-Gabriel, Sainte-Adèle, Quebec. The meeting concluded with the opening remarks of the Most Reverend Paul-André Durocher, Archbishop of Gatineau, as he begins his two-year term as President (2013-2015). Archbishop Durocher thanked his predecessor as President, the Most Reverend Richard Smith, Archbishop of Edmonton.
