Ascension of the Lord

How often have we grudgingly told a friend, "I'm happy for you", and only pretended to be happy for them? Some favour falls on them rather than on us and we half-heartedly congratulate them for their good luck.

The opening prayer for this day could sound like that, "make us rejoice for the Ascension of Christ". But the truth here is that the Ascension of Jesus should make us happy in the same way that the Resurrection of Jesus should make us happy.

The Ascension is an important part of the Easter mystery, part of how God chooses to save us. The Ascension is another aspect of how we hope to participate in the life of God, the life that through the Eucharist we touch, even now. This is not us grabbing on to Christ's coat tails as He rises, hoping to sneak into heaven. Rather, this paschal mystery means that we are offered the gift of salvation and are welcomed home as children of God.

Further to our conversation, I am happy to inform you that Bell Canada, acting as a good corporate citizen, will take care of all costs of the decontamination on the property located at 126, rue Joseph in Buckingham, Gatineau.

Bell Canada proudly regards this as a donation to the Our Lady of Victory Parish, in recognition and continuity of your good work with your parishioners, people in need in your neighborhood and your community. These costs amount to approximately \$43,565.00. I have added a copy of the Plan showing the position of the contaminated oil barrel and the sites of the excavation with the measures.
