


PENTECOST

Gifts and Fruits of the Spirit: The readings for this Sunday mention a number of gifts of the Spirit, for example, peace, forgiveness, being enabled to proclaim. The New Testament itself in a number of passages lists other gifts of the Spirit (see 1 Cor 12:4-11 and 28-31; Rom 12:6-8; Eph 4:7-12; 1 Pet 4:10-11) as well as the fruits of receiving the Holy Spirit (see Gal 5:22-23a). None of these lists of gifts is exactly the same; we are assured that each community is given whatever gifts it needs to build itself up to full stature as the Body of Christ (see Eph 4:11-13).

Since each community is given the gifts it needs to be the Body of Christ and continue Jesus' saving mission, if we examine these lists of gifts we are given a unique insight into each of these early communities. By the same token, if today we examine our own Christian communities and the gifts that are evident, we are also given a unique insight into **who** we are as the Body of Christ. The gifts of an individual manifest **who** that individual is. The gifts of a family manifest **who** that family is. **The gifts of a parish manifest who that parish is.** Let us discern our gifts and exercise them well for the good of others!

FIRST COMMUNION

DIOCESAN NEWS

The 2014-15 Diocesan Pastoral Launching will be held on Friday, June 13, 2014, at Ste-Maria-Goretti Church, Gatineau. Rather than the usual September Pastoral Launching, the Diocesan Pastoral Committee proposed to move it to the month of June in order to better prepare the coming Pastoral year (beginning in September). *Another Good News is that, for the first time, simultaneous translation will be provided for the English speaking participants*
