### MONTHLY PRAYER INTENTIONS FROM THE BISHOP SEPTEMBER 2014 – Persons with Mental Health Problems

#### Let us pray for people who have problems with mental health that they will receive the love and help they need to sustain their dignity and they will accept the treatment indicated for their condition.

## Reflection on Social Issues:

Many of today's mental health problems can be linked to a competitive and goals-oriented society which may overload people with work. We see burn-out, depression, anxiety and even suicide. De-institutionalization means that we may often encounter those who live with mental illness such as schizophrenia, addiction or bi-polar syndrome. How do we live within a society which includes those who are living with a mental illness?

## Our Faith Response:

Several Scripture passages show Jesus coming to the defense of the oppressed and marginalized of society. As believers in Jesus, we are invited to do as He did in order to help them improve their lives. In the Gospel of Matthew, He calls us to visit the sick: "I was sick and you visited me." Mt. 25:36. As a Christian, do I have a welcoming attitude towards those who are afflicted with mental illness?

Sunday, September 7, 2014 – Do I know anyone living with mental health illness? If so, what can I do for them? Can I visit them?
