

GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE SYNOD OF BISHOPS

The Holy Father has declared that on Sunday, September 28th, the whole Church is to pray for the III Extraordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops, which begins on Sunday, October 5th, to treat the topic “*The Pastoral Challenges of the Family in the Context of Evangelization*”. Following is a Prayer to the Holy Family for the Synod, composed by Pope Francis.

PRAYER TO THE HOLY FAMILY FOR THE SYNOD

Jesus, Mary and Joseph, in you we contemplate the splendour of true love, to you we turn with trust.

Holy Family of Nazareth, grant that our families too may be places of communion and prayer, authentic schools of the Gospel and small domestic Churches.

Holy Family of Nazareth, may families never again experience violence, rejection and division: may all who have been hurt or scandalized find ready comfort and healing.

Holy Family of Nazareth, may the approaching Synod of Bishops make us once more mindful of the sacredness and inviolability of the family, and its beauty in God's plan.

Jesus, Mary and Joseph, graciously hear our prayer.
