December is a month of over-consumption and often of indebtedness, a frantic race against the clock: parties, shopping, preparation of food, receptions; it is also a race to bring the professional year to a close. We experience this time of year as a period of stress, anxiety, agitation and even sadness. And yet, it is a time of joy, hope, love brotherhood, sharing and celebration.

Our Faith Response

As Christians, we experience Advent as a time of waiting, reflection, meditation and sharing. On Christmas Day we will celebrate the birth of our Saviour, our Redeemer, the "*Prince of Peace*" (Is. 9:5), Emmanuel "*God with us*". This period announces peace in our hearts and hope for a better world. Our gift exchanges, are they not a sign of friendship, sharing, and joy in and towards one another? It is a time when we recall the unconditional love of Jesus for each one of us. Let us allow the Spirit to fashion us from the inside so that we are able to live out our Christmas in truth, in simplicity and in peace. : Joy is within our reach and we are the ones responsible for it.
