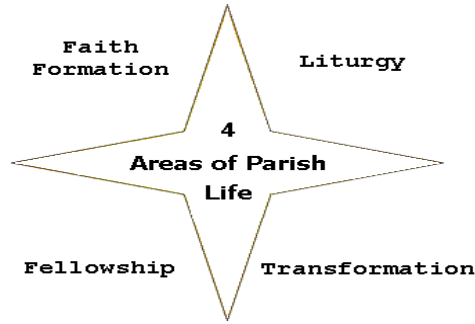

Partnerships

Recently, the Diocese asked the following questions – How do we best use the resources to help us to become true witnesses to the presence of God in our communities (parishes, regions, cities and villages)?

The challenge we face today, is the need to balance between business-based versus spiritual decisions. We need to be careful that our community's focus does not become entirely focused on business and fund raising to the detriment of living our faith. Beyond financial planning and fund raising activities, other priorities should also be on the table.

As part of our mission at OLV, we have tried to respond to these challenges by supporting groups who are making a contribution to individual well-being and the community as a whole. We are doing this through several initiatives.

Church Basement

Sunday nights - we make the hall available to **Narcotics Anonymous**, the largest of the groups we support, which is a testament to the rise of the drug culture in our society.

Monday nights - the hall is made available to **Alcoholics Anonymous**, who were the first group to approach us for support.

Tuesday nights - Overeaters Anonymous, the least known of the support groups, occupy the hall. The groups pay us what they can on a monthly basis and on numerous occasions have expressed their gratitude for our ongoing support. The fact of the matter is that without our support, these groups would probably have nowhere else to hold their meetings.

Also, the parish is partnering with **Relay for Life**, by providing the hall free of charge for two events, a garage sale and supper, in order to express our solidarity and support for the battle against cancer. Parishioners are encouraged to support these two activities.

Food Bank

Parishioners, on a weekly basis, donate food items which are transported to the local food bank. Parishioners are encouraged to continue their weekly donations in support of this worthy cause.

Cereal Bars

Similar to the food bank initiative, on a monthly basis parishioners donate cereal bars to the Buckingham Elementary School for students most in need.
