

Reading II Ephesians 1.3-14 Gospel Mark 6.7-13

> Jesus summoned the Twelve. "Summoned" is a significant word here. This is a call that cannot be ignored because the mission is so urgent.

As with Jesus summoning the Twelve in this Gospel, God summoned Amos in the first Reading to "prophesy to my people Israel." As with the Twelve, the mission of Amos was urgent.

When we receive a phone call and the voice of the caller sounds urgent, we respond immediately. We intently listen and then decisively act.

Jesus' summons of the Twelve is such a "phone call."
