<u>Our Local Food Bank - LA MIE DE L'ENTRAIDE</u>: A reminder to everyone that our local food bank has again installed a refrigerator outside the main door at 422 Pine Street. This refrigerator is an "anti-waste fridge" and is available to collect surplus fruits and vegetables from farmers, community gardens, grocers and citizens. Anyone can then anonymously take from this "fridge" whatever they need.

A few statistics:

4,200 requests for food per year; more and more seniors are visiting the food bank; single-parent families; working poor; people living alone; and 20% of the clients are English-speaking.

La mie de l'entraide also provides home-made meals as well as non-perishables to those who visit the food bank. Whenever they receive large quantities of different items from local grocers, volunteers use such food to make meals which are then frozen and distributed along with the non-perishables.

La mie de l'entraide is the only food bank in the Outaouais that provides perishable items such as meat, milk, eggs, fruits and vegetables. There are also items for sale to the general public, such as meat pies, apple pies, etc.

Our two parishes continue to collect non-perishable items in the baskets at the entrances to our churches. These items are delivered every week to *La Mie de l'entraide* who thank our parishioners for their generosity.
