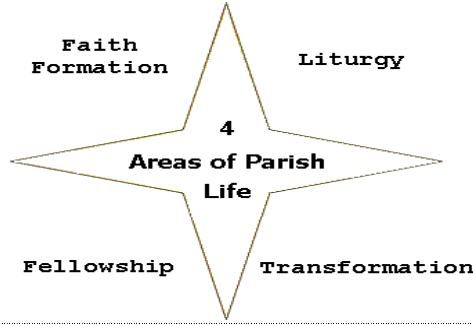

Father John Malazdrewich o.m.i. is now Pastor of St. Mark the Evangelist Parish in Gatineau (**Aylmer Sector**) from September 1st, 2016 until July 31st, 2022.
