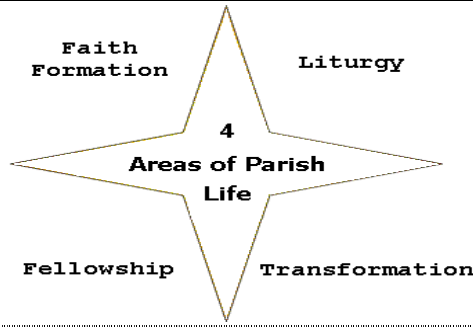

THE ARCHBISHOP'S MONTHLY PRAYER INTENTIONS: SEPTEMBER 2016

“So that Christians, by participating in the Sacraments, and by meditating on the Scriptures, become increasingly aware of their mission of evangelization.”

Social Reflection: Many people try to make the world a better place. In August 2016, more than 20,000 people gathered in Montreal for the World Social Forum, in the hopes of building a world that would be socially more just. Depending on our values, we may or may not support a certain government, political party, social group or charity. Our motivation is always to work for the *common good*.

Answering our Faith: Our religious practice strengthens us to become better people in everyday life. In our daily lives, we are invited to bear witness to a message of hope. The latter leads us towards *justice, peace* and the *common good*. Saint Paul once said; “For the Kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.” (Rm14, 17). So to evangelize, our testimony must also be reflected in our actions. At the beginning of the pastoral year, how can our pastoral project be put in action so that it serves justice, peace, and the common good?

Questioning ourselves: Sunday, September 4, 2016: This weekend, I reflect on our relationship with the labour market. Is minimum wage morally just, when seen through the optics of the common good?

NEWS FROM THE DIOCESE

The following changes are effective as of September 1st:

Father Daniel Kelly becomes the Administrator of Our Lady of the Annunciation Parish in Gatineau (Hull Sector) and also St. Stephen Parish in Chelsea. He will also be the English-language associate of St. Elizabeth Parish in Cantley. These assignments are for an undetermined time.

Father John Malazdrewich o.m.i. becomes Pastor of St. Mark the Evangelist Parish in Gatineau (Aylmer Sector) from September 1st, 2016 until July 31st, 2022.

Father Lomer Rooney becomes Associate of Our Lady of Mount-Carmel Mission, Kazabazua and Our Lady of Sorrows Mission, Venosta. This assignment is from September 1st, 2016 until July 31st, 2022.

Monsieur l'abbé Philippe Gendron, v.g., has renewed his assignment as Administrator of Saint-Alexandre et Saint-Matthew in Gatineau. He also resumes his function as Vicar General. These assignments are for an undetermined time.
