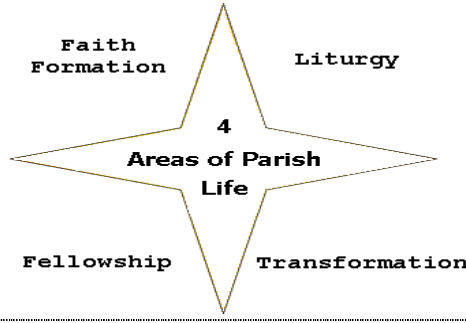

**Actions to do:** I read and examine in my heart this Sunday's readings as a seed the Lord wants to grow when the time has come.

## THINGS TO PONDER

When I don't produce the results I desire, it is very easy to feel I have failed. No matter where I find myself in life, every day presents new tasks and challenges.

Today's readings remind us that by doing our best, we have succeeded in God's eyes. We are seeds. In striving to please the Lord we continue to grow. ### **A New Initiative:**

The OLV wardens have entered into an agreement with a private daycare organization (Coup de Pouce Famille Inc.) to rent the church hall on **Wednesdays** during the summer. The hall will be rented from **7 am to 5 pm**. The ages of the children are from 3 to 5 years old and there will be around 10 children in the hall. This agreement is on a trial basis and will terminate on August 31<sup>st</sup>. At that point an assessment will be undertaken on whether to continue and add more days or to terminate.

This agreement is in line with the wardens' efforts to expand OLV's financial base.

**Summer Masses:** There will be **NO Thursday** masses during the months of July (starting July 5<sup>th</sup> and ending August 30<sup>th</sup>).
