Dîner pour mieux apprendre's annual fundraising campaign

Dîner pour mieux apprendre, formerly La Table de Bethléem / Oeuvre d'Edna Charette has launched a first major fundraising campaign. In our two parishes, we have a tradition of leaving our **Book of Life** at the front of the church for the month of November. The **Book** of Life contains the names of deceased parishioners and relatives.

Some additional pages are provided at the back of the book if anyone wants to add names. It is our way of expressing our faith that the dead find peace with God and will be raised to life when the Lord Jesus comes in glory.

The Book is placed next to the Easter Candle which speaks of the ultimate victory of life over death, of light over darkness, in the dead and risen Jesus. We are called to share in that victory. Next weekend, our parishes will have a special remembrance for the deceased from the past year.
