HELP A CHILD SUCCEED

***Dîner pour mieux apprendre's* annual fundraising campaign**

Dîner pour mieux apprendre, formerly *La Table de Bethléem / Oeuvre d'Edna Charette* has launched a first major fundraising campaign. Under the theme **Help a child succeed**, the population, merchants and businesses are invited to contribute generously to feed economically disadvantaged children attending elementary schools in the Lièvre territory.

Please offer prayers for the work of the Church in the missions today – the Pacific Islands, Latin America, Africa and Asia. And please be as generous as you can today, for *World Mission Sunday*.

The overall goal of the campaign is \$100,000, 100% of which will be invested in meal preparation. Feeding one child for the duration of the school year costs approximately \$900 in food, and the organization expects to feed over 100 children. This food security project has a direct impact on physical health, but also promotes education, socialisation, and integration into society. It gives every child an equal chance to succeed because hunger is a barrier to their growth, health and learning ability.

NOVEMBER – THE MONTH IN WHICH WE REMEMBER THE DECEASED

November is traditionally the month in which we give more attention to the remembrance of the deceased. Christians do so in a unique way based on what is central in our faith: the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

In our two parishes, we have a tradition of leaving our **Book of Life** at the front of the church for the month of November. The **Book of Life** contains the names of deceased parishioners and relatives.

Some additional pages are provided at the back of the book if anyone wants to add names. It is our way of expressing our faith that the dead find peace with God and will be raised to life when the Lord Jesus comes in glory.

The Book is placed next to the Easter Candle which speaks of the ultimate victory of life over death, of light over darkness, in the dead and risen Jesus. We are called to share in that victory. Next weekend, our parishes will have a special remembrance for the deceased from the past year.
