Somehow John the Baptist realized that this Jesus is the one to come. In the guidance of the Spirit, John has come to make Jesus known, and in Jesus' baptism John realized – he knew in his deepest being – that this was the Son of God.

Each of us can probably recall times when we have turned deaf ears to God; if we remember that God's call is relentless, then we might be encouraged to listen more carefully and sooner.
