

First Reading: Levitius 19.1-2, 17-18

Responsorial Psalm: The Lord is merciful and gracious

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 3.16-23
Gospel: Matthew 5.38-48

The teaching in today's Gospel is clear and uncompromising: "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you."

### **ASH WEDNESDAY**

#### The beginning of our 40-day trek to Easter

Next week, our churches will look a little different; they will have a Lenten look – the cross, the banners, the purples. They underline the fact that as Christians we are signing up for renewal on the way to Easter when we will have our baptism renewed.

The scripture readings and the music will sound different too as part of the Lenten repertoire. On Wednesday morning at 11:00 a.m., there will be a service at OLV in which we receive the ashes. The receiving of the ashes is a sign that we are serious about the upcoming season of renewal and conversion.

However, let us not lose sight of Easter. We do not observe Lent for its own sake. It is meant to get us in shape to celebrate the central mystery of our faith: The death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. That core mystery will be celebrated right after Lent during the Three Great Days of Holy Thursday evening, Good Friday, Easter Saturday/Easter Sunday.

On *Ash Wednesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup> at 11:00 a.m.*, we start our 40-day trek to Easter. We can mark the journey with the traditional Lenten practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving.
