

1st SUNDAY IN LENT



First Reading: Genesis 2.7-9, 16-18; 3.1-7

Responsorial Psalm: Have mercy, O Lord, for we have sinned

Second Reading: Romans 5.12-19
Gospel: Matthew 4.1-11

DIOCESAN APPROACH TO LENT IN LINE WITH THE SYNODAL PRIORITIES



The theme suggested for this Lent is *Living together the march towards Easter*. We note the very close link between this theme and the synodal process in which the Church is currently engaged (process of listening, dialogue and community discernment). The emphasis is on listening to the Word. A visual is proposed.

First Sunday in Lent 26 February 2023

<u>Listening to the Word of God: Matthew 4:1-11:</u> At Jesus' baptism, a voice said, "This is my beloved Son" (Mt 3:17). Immediately afterwards, moved by the Spirit, Jesus leaves the green banks of the Jordan for the desert of Galilee. He allows himself to be moved by the Spirit, who blows where and when he wills. For forty days and forty nights he fasts and prays. Hungry, exhausted, isolated and fragile, Jesus meets the tempter (also called the devil, i.e. the divider) who tries to sow doubt in his mind: "Is it true that you are the Son of God? He then makes three diabolical suggestions to him in succession: to change the stone into bread, to throw himself into the void from the top of the temple, to embrace the extent of the supreme power. Confident in his Father, concentrating on the essentials of his mission, Jesus resists the temptation to take shortcuts and does not give in to any of these three suggestions. Behind the temptations of Jesus are hidden or revealed our own temptations.
