

## Third Sunday and Week of Lent 2023 Listening to the Word of God: John 4:1-11

"The first reading of the third Sunday reminds us that journeys are sometimes trying, especially when the body, thirsty, and the spirit, out of breath, no longer follow. The book of Exodus tells of the disarray of the people of Israel mired in the sand of the desert. But God does not abandon his people. And in the second reading, Saint Paul reveals that whoever hopes in God cannot be disappointed. With God, a well, a fountain is never far away. It is precisely around a well that Jesus embarks on the itinerary of one of the most famous and lively dialogues with a woman from Samaria.
