Fourth Sunday in Lent, March 19, 2023


This is the 4th Sunday of Lent in our journey together towards Easter. For this Sunday, we propose a meeting made up of dialogue and welcome to be experienced in family, community, friends, team (parish or other). A dialogue based on spiritual conversation.

Today, we invite you to reflect on your experiences of welcome. Reflect on the calls to conversion in welcoming. Do we see obstacles that we could put in the way of welcome? Do we see places of conversion in our welcome? How do we welcome resistance to novelty, to change, to difference? It is important to know how to welcome these discomforts in order to change them.

Jesus gives us a criterion of discernment to help us see clearly: "I have come into this world to pass judgment: that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may be blinded" (Jn 9:39). Far from making us feel guilty, Jesus comes to bring his light so that we can see what is going on in us when it comes to welcoming the other. Jesus is the Light that makes us become, in Him, light so that our welcome is a fruit of goodness, justice and truth.
