



The set of banners you see in the front of the church at Our Lady of Victory will be with us for the next 50 days, covering the entire Easter season, until Pentecost Sunday, May 28. They are more than a piece of decoration. In vivid images, they capture what as church we are about in the Easter season.

The cross, which on its own is an instrument of torture and shame, has been transformed into the tree of life. That is what the resurrection of Jesus makes possible. The sun of the new creation has dawned and the roots of the cross, of the tree of life reach into the darkest corners of our human existence to bring life. Part of that new creation is that the risen Christ shares his life-giving Spirit with us; that is captured in the red banner with its flames of fire. The lower banner shows us how in the waters of baptism we have got our feet in the new creation of the risen Jesus.

**Father Normand Carpentier** passed on March 26, 2023 in Gatineau. Born in Buckingham on December 6, 1940, he was the son of the late René Carpentier and the late Alice Mallette and brother of Paul, Louis, Pierre, Richard, Luc, Yolaine, Jeanne d'Arc, Madeleine, Louise and the late Claudette.

After his theological studies at the Major Seminary of Ottawa, he was ordained to the priesthood on June 5,1966 at the church of Saint-Grégoire de Nazianze, Buckingham by Bishop Paul-Émile Charbonneau of Hull.

He ministered in the following parishes Saint-Richard, Saint-Matthieu, Saint-Alexandre (Gatineau), Saint-Dominique (Luskville); the Unité de la Vigne (Saint-René-Goupil, Saint-Jean-Marie-Vianney and Sainte-Maria-Goretti, Gatineau), Notre-Dame-du Mont-Carmel (Duhamel), Saint-Émile-de-Suffolk, Saint-Félix-de-Valois (Chénéville) and Sainte-Valérie (Boileau).

Chaplain in schools, he held various positions in the diocese, such as: diocesan director of pastoral care, secretary general, in charge of the chancery and archives, in charge of community service and sacramental initiation, coordinator of diocesan pastoral care, vicar general and member of several committees.

The funeral, presided over by Bishop Paul-André Durocher, will take place at Saint-Grégoire-de-Nazianze Church on April 15, 2023 at 1:30 p.m.
