

A LOOK BACK AT THE ARCHBISHOP'S BRUNCHES ON OCTOBER 22nd AND NOVEMBER 5th

On October 22nd, the Archbishop's Benefit Brunch for parishes in the Petite-Nation pastoral region was held at the Buckingham Knights of Columbus Hall. Over 125 people accepted the invitation, and the brunch raised \$5,000 to support 10 community organizations in the Petite-Nation. On November 5, Ste-Trinité parish hosted the brunch for parishes in the Greater Gatineau, West and Central pastoral regions. The brunch was preceded by Sunday mass presided over by Archbishop Durocher, and over 200 people gathered for the event in the church basement. Proceeds of \$6,700 were donated to eight Gatineau community organizations. The brunches were also an opportunity for fundraising partner Fondation Novatio to officially launch its first annual fundraising campaign, with a target of \$50,000. The Archbishop's Brunch Tour was made possible thanks to sponsors, including Les Jardins du Souvenir, as well as local teams who took charge of food preparation and service. The last brunch for 2023 was held at the Salle paroissiale Christ-Roi in Maniwaki, on November 19th.

Subject: World Youth Day (WYD) at diocesan level - 26 November 2023

Bishop Paul-André Durocher invites all young people to the Diocesan World Youth Day celebration on Sunday, November 26th, 2023. The presentation of the youth groups, followed by a special Mass will be held on the feast of Christ the King of the Universe, from 3pm to 6pm at St-François de Sales Church (799 Rue Jacques-Cartier, Gatineau, QC J8T 2W1)). It will be a colourful, joyful and festive celebration as part of World Youth Day, which will be celebrated that day in dioceses around the world. At the same time, our diocese will be launching a Diocesan Youth Ministry Table. This is a round table that will support the various experiences of youth groups. <u>Action</u>: We invite you to encourage young teenagers, young adults (students, young people in the job market or waiting for a job), as well as parish youth group leaders to join us.
