It reminds us that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. It recognizes the great efforts of doctors, nurse, health care institutions and pastoral care givers to restore health to those afflicted with illness and disease.

MESSAGE FROM THE DIOCESE

Ash Wednesday (14 February) marks the beginning of Lent 2024. Far from being a time of sadness, it is in fact a time of discernment, hope and grace. The Gospel of Ash Wednesday helps us rediscover the three fundamentals of Lent: praying, sharing and fasting. **Praying** means breathing and living to the rhythm of the Father, the Son and the Spirit. It means letting yourself be seduced by the Word of God. **Sharing** is being attentive to others. Of course, we can share things like our time, our talents, our money, bread, useless leftovers that we get rid of... but sharing is fundamentally about putting ourselves at the service of others. There is more joy in giving than in receiving, as the Book of Acts reminds us (Acts 20:35). **Fasting:** why fast? To fast is to enter into the Spirit's impulse to detach ourselves, to free ourselves from everything that can hinder our relationship with the Lord, our listening to his word, his presence in our lives.
