

QR CODE ON COVER OF PARISH BULLETIN

3rd Sunday of Lent B - The Lord opens the way for us

One winter, on our way to Quebec City for Christmas, we were surprised by the snow that kept falling. Traffic got slower and slower, until we began to see the snowplow flashing in the distance. <u>Mass announcements:</u> During the Eucharistic Prayer, prayers for the deceased (for those who have paid for a mass), will be read at this time.


