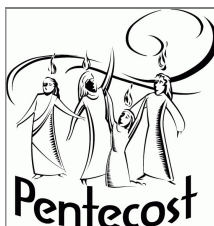
QR CODE ON COVER OF PARISH BULLETIN

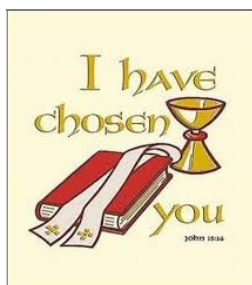

PENTECOST

PENTECOST, LIKE EASTER, is a major feast inherited from ancient Israel's liturgical calendar. The Greek word for it, meaning "fiftieth (day)", refers to the span of days between Passover and Pentecost. It was originally an agricultural feast celebrating the first fruits of harvest. It soon took a deeper meaning in Judaism relating to the history of salvation and became the feast commemorating the gift of Torah at Mount Sinai. Just as ancient Israel fully became God's people through the gift of Torah and the covenant made at Mount Sinai, so the Church, the New Israel, gets its full stature at Pentecost with the gift of the Spirit.

In the last seven weeks, we have focused on the foundational and central mystery of Christianity: the Resurrection of the Lord. Jesus remains with us until the end of time (Matthew 28:20), although not physically. ·

- Do we believe that the Spirit of Pentecost is still at work in the Church and in the world? ·
- What has become of the fire kindled by the Spirit? ·
- Of the boldness and the freedom that we could see at work in the Apostles on the day of Pentecost?

Fifty years ago, Pope John XXIII prayed that Vatican II be "a new Pentecost and a new Spirit in the Church." Let us welcome the Spirit to create in us a new heart and set the world ablaze with love.
