LENT - OUR MOUNTAIN CLIMBING TOWARDS EASTER HAS BEGUN

Next Wednesday, March 5th, the church will take on a Lenten look - we will begin our journey to Easter with Ash Wednesday.

Fr. Greg will celebrate Ash Wednesday at 9:00 am at Our Lady of Victory church and a 7:00 pm at St. Aloysius.

How will we mark our 40-day trek to Easter? The traditional Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are aiming to get us in shape for Easter.

Prayer	Our Sunday liturgies, with their rich Bible readings, will provide the basic orientation for Lent.			
Fasting	We deprive ourselves; we cut down on food and drink for a variety of reasons. During Lent, we could refrain from some food, from a drink, from a party, from a video or movie as a gesture of solidarity with so many of those in our world who have no choice in these matters for the simple reason that they do not have them.			
Almsgiving	This flows naturally from the previous two practices. Almsgiving says we care for others even to the point of depriving ourselves from something. How about if we put the money that we save by some form of fasting aside and make it into our contribution to the special <i>Development and Peace</i> Share Lent collection that will be held later in Lent?

What is a Jubilee? Celebrated every 25 years in the Catholic Church, a Jubilee is a special year of forgiveness and reconciliation in which people are invited to come back into right relationships with God, with one another and with all Creation. The tradition is inspired by the biblical year of jubilee, a time when debts were cancelled, slaves were set free and the land was allowed to rest (Lev. 25, Deut. 15).

This year, under the theme "Pilgrims of Hope," Pope Francis invites Catholics to renew their hope and adopt a vision that can "restore access to the fruits of the earth to everyone."
