#### **FATHER GREG'S LENTEN MESSAGE**

It is not so much the things we do wrong as it is the things we leave undone that prevent us from growing in the love of Christ. The real problem is that too often we are guilty of sins of omission and neglect, of which we are hardly even conscious. Jesus confronts this very situation among his own followers, who believe that they are righteous because they haven't committed any sins grave enough to cause their destruction, as did the Galileans whom Pilate killed or those on whom the tower of Siloam fell. Jesus is saying that it takes a lot more then avoiding sin to be righteous, to be his disciple. It isn't our trifling failures that are the ultimate problem, but our lack of love. As scripture says: "...love covers a multitude of sins."

The Lenten invitation to repentance is not merely a call to turn away from evil but a plea to produce the fruits of good living. All of us have received a great deal from God. How concerned are we about giving something in return? Are we takers only, or are we givers as well? Reaching out in love demands that we get out of ourselves and begin to put aside our selfishness and allow God's love to take firm root in our hearts.
