FATHER GREG'S LENTEN MESSAGE

The first thing that strikes one about the gospel message for this Sunday of Lent is the sense of personal freedom portrayed in the scene, the scope that Jesus gives to the exercise of human freedom to choose, and the emphasis on the workings of conscience. Although the atmosphere is tense with expectation, Jesus defuses the situation by taking it out of the realm of public controversy and making of it a matter of personal responsibility. Jesus' very stance, siting on the ground and writing in the dirt, seems to say: don't look to me to judge between you, you have a conscience, you know the difference between right and wrong, you decide, but be aware that your decisions have consequences, both for yourself and for other people.

Conscience needs to be our guide in the choices we make, but conscience informed by the truth, by scripture, by God's revelation, by the example of Jesus, and by the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, not by the world and its deceptions. Conscience as the voice of God, and not of our own self-will; never as a justification for doing whatever we like, in obvious contradiction to God's law to God's law. Conscience doesn't say one thing to me and the complete opposite to you, but neither does it tell me to condemn you. Jesus did not condemn either the adulterous woman or the pharisees, rather he left the door open for a change of heart, allowing both to make their peace with God, and with themselves, free to choose the direction they would follow.
