WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

The Fourth Sunday of Easter, Christians are invited to reflect on the meaning of God's call and to pray for vocations. Christ, the Good Shepherd, continues to lead his people through His Bishops, Priests and Deacons, and calls many to follow Him in this way. Priestly, diaconal and religious vocations should be a constant concern in the hearts of God's people.

ELECTION OF A SUCCESSOR TO POPE FRANCIS

The cardinals are preparing to elect the successor of Pope Francis at the conclave to be opened on 7 May. As they meet now in general congregations, here is a prayer that those who desire it can recite so that the Holy Spirit may inspire them and be the master of the conclave.

Meeting in general congregations, the cardinals prepare to elect the successor of Pope Francis. Who is the master of the conclave who is to open on 7 May? Humanly, the Cameroonian cardinal, Kevin Farrell. For those who look supernaturally at this world – let's be sure that the cardinals themselves – the 134 voters present will act under the inspiration of the third person of the Trinity. So here is a prayer to the Holy Spirit to recite to ask him to inspire the cardinals and to be the pivot of the conclave.

God and Eternal Father,

You who want the flock of your church to graze in the green pastures of your grace, give us a pastor who reminds the world of your benevolent design, a shepherd who encourages his brothers and sisters, to the mercy and missionary leadership.

Christ Jesus, the only Savior and Spouse of your Church, be the example of each cardinal, let them keep their eyes fixed on the cross, may they be renewed by your resurrection and self-confidence in their faith, let them be aware that they will be judged on love, let them testify to the gift of their lives.

Lord Holy Spirit, be the inner master of each. Spirit of counsel, give them to listen to your voice. Spirit of wisdom, make them discern the good of the Church.

Spirit of intelligence, gives everyone the concern for the truth. Spirit of science, show them that everything is in the hands of the Father. Spirit of strength, keep them brave against the spirit of the world. Spirit of fear, save their humility. Spirit of piety, keep them in prayer. Let the general congregations and the conclave remain under your constant protection, let everything take its source from you and receive from you its full completion. And when you wanted to give the Church his new Bishop of Rome, give him all your gifts, for the glory of God and the salvation of the world, grant to all the faithful peace and joy, and the certainty that you will watch over the Church forever.

Financial

Communication

- · Manage incoming correspondence and ensures that incoming issues are addressed.
- Ensure that parishioners are kept informed of issues and events.

Other Items

- Ensure the completion of the Annual Report for the Régie des Entreprises by November 15th.
- Identify items and prepare agenda for the monthly warden meeting.
- · Allocate areas of responsibility (files) for each warden.
- Ensure that the Fabrique Act is respected.
- Manage the snow removal contract. Determine if the removal of snow is completed in a timely fashion.

Rentals (Warden Responsibility)

- Ensure that guidelines including a payment schedule are in place for the management of rental agreements.
- In collaboration with the Wardens review annual rental rates and make adjustments accordingly.
