

# Invitation to the Launch Workshops for the 2025–2026 Pastoral Year in Our Diocese

To all parish priests of the Archdiocese of Gatineau:

## Dear brothers priests,

The launch of the diocesan pastoral year marks the beginning of a new cycle of pastoral and missionary life in a diocese. It often involves the announcement of a theme that guides and renews pastoral momentum and projects to mobilize parish communities around a common mission.

The proposed theme for the next two pastoral years is: **The Church in the Outaouais – Together to Sow Its Light.** This theme was formulated during a shoulder-to-shoulder meeting held in July, attended by approximately ten members of the diocese led by Bishop Paul-André Durocher. The objective of this theme is to strengthen or rekindle the missionary spirit of parish communities and help them rediscover themselves as signs and bearers of light and hope here in the Outaouais region. Our bishop's pastoral letter will further clarify the announced theme.

For this pastoral year, training evenings will be held on the dates below and will be organized by zone.

We invite parish communities and Church movements to register as soon as possible. Particularly invited are members of pastoral teams, members of local pastoral animation teams, members of church assembly, people involved in various liturgies, priests, deacons, parish leaders and those from different parish movements, etc.

- September 8, 2025, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Sainte-Trinité parish hall for the Central pastoral zone
- September 9, 2025, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at Our Lady of the Annunciation parish for the English pastoral zone
- September 10, 2025, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Notre-Dame de Fatima parish hall for the Western pastoral
- **September 11, 2025**, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the St-André-Avellin pastoral hall for the Eastern and Petite Nation pastoral zones
- September 13, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to noon at the Assumption of Mary parish in Maniwaki for the Northern pastoral zone.

You are invited to submit a representative delegation, based on the size of your parish's pastoral and organizational team, to participate in these important workshops.
