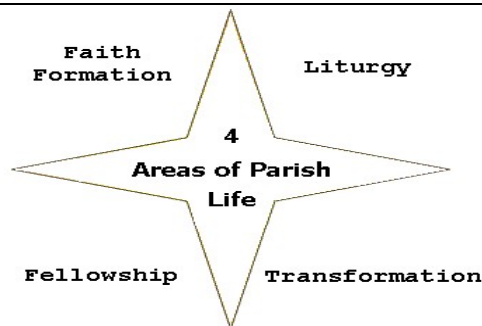

FATHER JOHN’S MESSAGE

November, the month to pray especially for the dead.

Love can be both a joy and a painful purification especially when you know it is coming from Someone who loves you so immensely. It is joyful in so far you experience the love of the God, but painful is so far as you desire wholly to be like the one you love and know you are not yet so. St. Catherine of Genoa (1447–1510), is famous for her Treatise on Purgatory, which offers a profound perspective that perfectly addresses the need to emphasize love and purification over mere punishment. She portrays Purgatory not as a place where God *sends* souls, but where the soul *casts itself* in a burning desire to be purged of any remaining stain before encountering Christ. Here is one of her sayings: "The souls in Purgatory have a joy so great that no tongue can describe it; but it is combined with a pain so extreme that no tongue can tell of it. Yet the one does not diminish the other." The birth of a child is both painful and joyful at the same time! Purgatory reflects this kind of experience but in a spiritual way and for a period until the full birth into eternal life is done.

PENITENTIAL RITE

On **December 11th at 7pm** there will be an ***Advent Penitential Service at OLV***. An Advent Penitential Service prepares you to celebrate the great feast of Christmas worthily and well. Advent is a time to prepare for the four-fold coming of Jesus, in grace into our hearts, at the hour of our death, at Christmas and at his Second Coming. After our common prayer and examination of conscience there will be an opportunity to confess individually. **All are welcome!**

On **December 14th and 15th, Sunday and Monday**, Fr. John will also lead us in a mini Advent Retreat at OLV. Father will lead us in an Advent/Christmas reflection and there will be some time for discussion and questions as well. **All are welcome!**
