

CREATING HOPE AT THE G7 JUBILEE PEOPLE'S FORUM

In the picturesque resort town of Kananaskis, Alberta, world leaders invited by the Government of Canada met at the G7 Summit to discuss what they saw as the most significant issues of our time. Yet, secluded in the Canadian Rockies, the summit met far away from civil society, causing many to wonder whether leaders could hear the voices of the people to whom they are accountable.

In the days leading up to the G7, a creative and global community gathered in nearby Calgary for the G7 Jubilee People's Forum, a time to meet, share strategies, educate one another, work creatively, and discuss what we saw as the most significant issues of our time. Organized by KAIROS, Development and Peace — Caritas Canada (DPCC), the Office of Religious Congregations for Integral Ecology (ORCIE), the Canadian Council of Churches, and Citizens for Public Justice (CPJ), the forum hosted participants from Kenya and Palestine to Washington and Whitehorse.
