

Covid-19 Vaccination Operation in Quebec

How to get vaccinated

- COVID-19 vaccination is being done in stages and is reserved for people in priority groups for the moment.
- As of March 1st, in the Outaouais, people 80 years of age or older (born in or before 1941) can start making appointments to get vaccinated. Please note that an appointment is mandatory and that the planned order of vaccination in your region must be followed.
- To book an appointment on line, go to <https://portal3.clicsante.ca/> and follow the instructions below:
 - ❖ If the webpage opens in French go to the top right corner of the screen and click on **English**.
 - Click on **Select a Service**
 - In **Select a Service**, click on **COVID-19 Vaccine**
 - Click on **Choose This Service**
 - Enter your postal code
 - Click on **Search**
 - Click on **Book an Appointment** at the **Buckingham Community Centre**

- **Important!** Do not forget to complete the registration of your accompanying person after completing your own appointment if they meet the following criteria:
 - They are 70 years of age or older;
 - They are present/on-site 3 days a week or more to support the family member who is 80 years of age or older.
 - We assure you that no matter what time you select for this second appointment for the accompanying person, they will be able to get vaccinated at the same time as you.
- If you are not part of the group that is being vaccinated, do not call or show up to get vaccinated. You will be informed at the appropriate time when your age group can start making appointments.
